



# Housing Crisis

If you are homeless or are at risk of homelessness there are organisations that can help you find assistance. Below are a few options. This list is not exhaustive so contacting some of these organisations can lead to further support options.

## **Homeless Hotline: 1800 474 753**

This is a phone information and referral service for people who are facing homelessness or who are experiencing homelessness. This service can help you find support, accommodation, meals and showers.



## **DV Connect: 1800 811 811**

Help for families experiencing domestic, family and sexual violence to find emergency transport and accommodation for you family (including pets). Additional services provided by this service is safety planning, crisis counselling, intervention and referrals.



## **DV Connect Mensline: 1800 600 636**

This service is service is available for men experiencing domestic violence (and men who are using violence in their relationship)

### Tenants QLD: 1300 744 263
